Between Montorio and the Santibáñez Valley, west of the Merindad del Río Ubierna, rises the beautiful Burgos town of Huércemes, a historical link between the Castilian countryside and the Cantabrian Mountains.

The palaces and stone houses that dot the cobblestone streets of this small town bear witness to a prosperous past as the center of power of the Castilian high nobility, when it was granted the title of Villa. Its monumental heritage is made up of the church of San Juan Bautista, the hermitage of Cuesta del Castillo and the palaces of the Archbishop or of the Fernández Zorrilla and that of the Alonso de Burgos.

With a privileged natural environment and a rich traditional gastronomy, Huércemes is the ideal destination to combine culture and nature.
