The most emblematic civil building in Burgos, built in the 15th century by the Condestables de Castilla. The work of Simon de Colonia. The portal with the franciscan cordon and a renaissance patio are noteworthy. The Reyes Católicos received Christopher Columbus here in 1497, after his second journey to America.
