

Parish Church of San Pelayo



15th-century church with a superb Plateresque altarpiece of the 16th century with paintings by the Maestro Olivares. A total of 53 oil paintings dating from 1526.

The altarpiece shows the prophets of the Old Testament, the apostles and saints (the life of San Pelayo under the sign of San Martirio, the imprisonment and death of San Pelayo, the Mysteries of the Holy Virgin, such as the Annunciation, Coronation, Assumption; Christ being judged by Pilate...
