

Church of Santa Maria de la Cuesta



The temple was built in the XII century with Templar origins. Its elevation of the village that surrounds it highlights and hence the name 'de la Cuesta'. It is a representative work of the Mudejar Romanesque of the village, with important Baroque reforms, built in ashlar stone, masonry and brick.
