




















introduction

It is a pleasure to be able to place in your hands this guide that includes twenty-four routes prepared in collaboration with twenty-four tourism professionals of Castilla y León, twenty-four agencies that bring you their experience in the Autonomous Community to help you discover a representative sample of the history, nature, wine and gastronomy assets of Castilla y León.

Castilla y León, comprised of nine provinces (Ávila, Burgos, León, Palencia, Salamanca, Segovia, Soria, Valladolid and Zamora), is one of the largest territories in Europe, which makes it the ideal destination to enjoy tourism in all its variety. Our Community has over the largest number of World Heritage Sites recognized by the UNESCO, II as a whole, 35 Protected Natural Areas, and close to 4.000 rural establishments. The gastronomy and wine of Castilla y León are another of its most notable resources, with 9 Certified Wine Routes, more than 150 Wineries open to visitors and 17 Designations of Origin.

Also, Castilla y León has excellent communications, a modern network of motorways, dual carriageways, roads and extensive rail links, now including the High Speed Train, with seven cities connected with high speed train.

This promotional guide has been produced with professionals from the tourism industry, with many years of experience in the organisation of trips, who have shared their knowledge in order to help you plan your journey around Castilla y León.

The rich heritage of Castilla y León includes in particular its World Heritage Sites. A natural and cultural legacy belonging to all humanity, and symbols of the growing awareness of States and peoples as to the meaning of these locations and the importance of handing this heritage down to future generations.



Castilla y León is home to 11 World Heritage Sites: the cities of Ávila, Salamanca and Segovia; the archaeological site of the Sierra de Atapuerca, in the province of Burgos; the landscape of Las Médulas Natural Monument; the Palaeolithic cave art of Siega Verde, in the province of Salamanca; The French Route of the Pilgrim's Way to Santiago; the Burgos Cathedral; the Mediterranean Diet; the Falconry; the Cuesta Fría and Canal de Asotín beech forests in León, and the Riaza Beech forest in Segovia.

Its imposing monuments, as well as its scientific, cultural, natural and historical significance, have all earned inclusion on the UNESCO list. An institution that since 1960 has tasked itself with protecting cultural and natural treasures deemed to be of outstanding universal value.

For Castilla y León, this recognition means the responsibility to contribute to proper conservation, development and promotion. In accordance with which, we here present this quide to showcase and explain why these eleven historical sites have been declared uniquely worthy of such an honourable distinction.

MODERNISM ON THE PILGRIMS' ROUTE TO SANTIAGO

DAY 1 · Route: Airport (Madrid, Bilbao, DAY 4 · Route: From Rome to Santiago

Santander) - Aguilar de Campoo (Palencia). The first part of our trip will be dedicated to discovering the Northern Romanesque, one of the world's largest and finest collections of Romanesque art. The 'Magic of Light' is our first proposal which includes evening tour of Santa María la Real Monastery (12th century) in Aguilar de Campoo shrouded in a twilight atmosphere of mystery and intrigue. Accommodation will be at the historic Posada Real in Aguilar de Campoo: magnificent hotel housed inside this ancient Monastery.

DAY 2 • A tour of the great Northern Romanesque monasteries.

This route provides a greater insight into the Northern Romanesque, taking us to the great Romanesque monasteries located in the surroundings of the Palentina mountain range: San Andrés de Arroyo, San Pelayo de Perazancas de Ojeda, the monastery of Santa Eufemia de Cozuelos or the former convent of Santa María de Mave.

To end the day, we will enjoy a musical concert at the Monastery of Santa María la Real in Aguilar de Campoo before spending the night at the Posada Real.

DAY 3 · Route through the rural gems of the Northern Romanesque.

The Northern Romanesque territory is an authentic natural museum that stands out for its incomparable landscapes, dotted with Romanesque churches. On this route, we present some of the most picturesque: the rock church in Olleros, the Church of Santos Julián y Basilisa in Rebolledo de la Torre and the Church of San Juan de Moarves Ojeda. We will finish the day with a tour of the historic monastery in Carrión de los Condes on the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago, where we will also spend the night.

DAY 4 • Route: From Rome to Santiago: The Pilgrims' Route to Santiago in Palencia.

Today's programme begins with a tour of the finest examples of Romanesque architecture on the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago in the province of Palencia: The Church of San Martin (Frómista) and the Monastery of San Zoilo (Carrión de los Condes). After this we will visit one of the most important archaeological sites in the Hispanic Roman world, Olmeda Villa (4th century CE), before continuing to León where we will spend two nights at a hotel located in a historic building.

DAY 5 · Route: monumental and gastronomic León.

León, one of the principal cities on the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago, holds a host of surprises for travellers. We will visit one of the bestpreserved Romanesque treasures, the Royal Collegiate Church of San Isidoro, known as the 'Sistine Chapel of the Romanesque' due to its spectacular paintings. Other highlights include the magnificent Gothic cathedral, which boasts a unique series of stained glass windows, undoubtedly the finest in Spain. Finally, we will travel to the 19th century with a dramatised tour (Saturdays) of Casa Botines, designed by the master architect Antoni Gaudí and which is now open to the public for the first time ever. We will also have the opportunity to enjoy the magnificent culinary delights of this city, declared the 2018 Capital of Spanish Gastronomy.

DAY 6 · Route: Astorga.

Our itinerary also includes a visit to Astorga, which stands on the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago. Highlights include the Cathedral of Santa María, built in various styles (Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque), and the original Episcopal Palace, another of the few buildings designed by Antoni Gaudí that can be visited outside Catalonia. Return to the airport of origin.



CASTILLA Y LEÓN: UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITES, ART AND LANDSCAPE

DAY 1 · Madrid - Aranda de Duero - Burgos

Arrival in Madrid and departure towards Aranda de Duero, located in the wine-growing region Ribera de Duero, where we will have the opportunity to taste its high quality wines.

Possibility of visiting a cellar for wine tasting.

We will spend time in the picturesque historical district of Aranda de Duero, where we will be able to gaze upon its churches -Santa María and San Juan-, palaces and estates -the Verdugo and the Colmenares Palaces- as well as the Romanesque bridge. Continue to Burgos for overnight

DAY 2 · Burgos and Atapuerca

In the morning we will visit the archeological area of Sierra de Atapuerca, located in the province of Burgos and declared World Heritage site by UNESCO in 2000 as it is the only place in Europe where the evolution of the lifestyle of primitive man to settle in our continent can be studied.

In the afternoon we will devote our time to Burgos, capital of the medieval Kingdom of Castile and León. There we will be able to admire its magnificent Gothic cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site, as well as nearby estates -including the Casa del Cordón- and the Royal Monastery of the Huelgas Reales. Overnight in Burgos

DAY 3 · Burgos – Frómista – Carrión – León

Today we continue along the Route of Santiago between Burgos and León. Frómista has the beautiful church of San Martín where we will find an intrinsically pure Romanesque style. Next to San Martín we find the churches of San Pedro and Santa María.

Carrión de los Condes is a site of great importance along the Ruta Jacobea and presents the Church of Santiago with its splendid Pantocrator. Other worthy sites in the area are the Santa María del Camino church, the Santa Clara Convent and the San Zoilo Monastery. Continue to León for overnight

DAY 4 · León

León, the former Roman Legio VII Gemina Pia Felix has an ample legacy of Romanesque, Gothic and Renaissance styles which we will appreciate during

We will pass through the historical district with the charming Plaza Mayor, the Gothic cathedral with its incomparable stained glass windows, and the San Isidoro Basilica known as the "Sistine Chapel" of the Spanish Romanesque style where the Royal Pantheon and magnificent 12th century frescoes

During our visit we will discover palaces -the Conde Luna, the Guzmanes-, churches such as San Salvador de Palat del Rey and the modernist Casa de los Botines by architect Antonio Gaudí. Overnight in León.

DAY 5 · León – Astorga – Zamora – Salamanca

Departure to Astorga, capital of the Maragatería Region. A point of intersection between such notable routes as the Path to Santiago de Compostela and the Silver Route, the old Roman city of Asturica Augusta offers the visitor interesting Roman ruins, an enchanting Plaza Mayor with the notable Town Hall building, Cathedral, and a Modernist structure of particular interest: the Episcopal Palace by architect Antonio Gaudí, that holds the Museum of the Pilgrimages. Today's route takes us to Zamora. Possibility of visiting a local producer for a cheese tasting.

The Romanesque City awaits us on the banks of the Duero River: Zamora and its characteristic Romanesque cathedral with the Byzantine style cupola. During our visit we will enjoy an impressive assembly of Romanesque churches: San Ildefonso, La Magdalena or San Cipriano, as well as the Plaza Mayor. Continue to Salamanca for overnight

DAY 6 · Salamanca

Salamanca, UNESCO World Heritage site, this beautiful university city invites us to discover its rich historical past, wander through its lively streets and experience the festive atmosphere. Among its notable monuments are the Baroque style Plaza Mayor, the House of Shells, the two cathedrals, the University, the San Esteban Convent and the Casa Lis that houses the interesting Art Nouveau and Art Déco Museum. Overnight in Salamanca

DAY 7 · Salamanca – Ávila – Segovia

The end of our journey takes us to two monumental cities, both declared UNESCO World Heritage

Ávila, birthplace to the famous Spanish mystics Santa Teresa de Jesús and Saint John of the Cross (Fóntiveros, Ávila), welcomes us with its impressive walls, its cathedral, the San Vincent Basilica, palaces and family estates -the Veladas, Valderrábanos, Núñez Velas and Torreón de los Guzmanes-, as well as the Monastery of the Incarnation.

In the afternoon we will visit Segovia with its spectacular Roman Aqueduct, a jewel of Roman engineering built in the 1st century. As we walk through the Jewish Quarter, we will have the opportunity to behold the Casa de los Picos, the Alhóndiga and the Torreón de los Lozoya fortress.

We will visit the Gothic cathedral known as the "Lady of Cathedrals" as well as the defensive Alcázar fortress. Overnight in Segovia.

Possibility of organizing a special farewell dinner

DAY 8 · Segovia - Madrid

Transfer to the Madrid Airport.



RIBERA DEL DUERO WINE ROUTE

DAY 1 · Monday: Point of Origin – Aranda de Duero.

Departure from the established points of origin and stops en route. Arrival in Aranda and guided tour of the city. Dinner and accommodation.

DAY 2 · Tuesday: Ribera del Duero in Valladolid.

Breakfast and departure for the Cistercian Monastery in Valbuena (Valladolid) for a guided tour. From there we will make our way to Peñafiel to visit the castle, squares and churches, as well as the Wine Museum. Free time for lunch followed by an afternoon winery tour (approx. I hour 30 min including wine tasting). Return to the hotel for dinner.

DAY 3 · Wednesday: Medieval Aromas.

Breakfast and departure (around 9 a.m.) for Santa Cruz de la Salceda in the heart of the Ribera del Duero region and near Aranda, home to the only 'European Aromas' museum. From here we head to Maderuelo, a delightful medieval village in the province of Segovia. Perched on top of a hill, it is crossed by the River Riaza and is close to the Linares Reservoir. Free time to stroll around the streets that were the setting for the 'Tierra de Lobos' television series.

Departure for the medieval villages of Pedraza and Sepúlveda. Free time for lunch in Pedraza and a guided tour of both villages.

DAY 4 · Tuesday: Ribera del Duero in Burgos.

Breakfast and departure for Peñaranda de Duero, where we will have a guided visit. From here we make our way to La Vid, site of the Monastery of Santa María de la Vid. Restaurant lunch consisting of traditional suckling lamb roasted in a wood-fired oven. This is followed by a visit to a famous winery and a wine tasting session. Return to the hotel.

DAY 5 • Friday: Monastery of Santo Domingo de Silos Monastery and Covarrubias.

Breakfast and departure for Santo Domingo de Silos and a guided tour of the monastery and a non-guided visit to the village. We will then go to Covarrubias, a medieval village where there will be free time for lunch, followed by a guided tour. (55 min at 4.30 p.m.PM) Free time. Return to the hotel and free time.

DAY 6 · Saturday: Aranda - Point of Origin.Breakfast and return to points of origin.





DAY 1 · Arrival in Madrid - Aranda del Duero - Ribera del Duero wineries.

Depart Madrid for the Ribera de Duero area where you will spend most of the day in Peñafiel visiting family-owned wineries, the fabulous castle, the historic quarter with its landmark Plaza Mayor, and a traditional cheese maker's workshop. Enjoy tasting the suckling lamb at a special welcome lunch. Next stop is Aranda, to see how the wine barrels are charred, explore 13th century wine cellar caves and stroll around the town. Accommodation in Tordesillas.

DAY 2 · Ribera del Duero Winery - Rueda Wineries.

After breakfast we begin our visit to a Ribera del Duero winery, and the chance to taste the wine, oil and gourmet cheeses. The first wine tasting session is followed by a visit to another winery, this time in Rueda, which produces wines from Spain's four top Designations of Origin: Rueda, Ribera de Duero, Toro and Rioja. However, Rueda is considered to be the original one. The winery organises tasting sessions and there is a shop. There is also a magnificent recreation of the Minotaur's Labyrinth where visitors can experience what this maze-like construction was really like. There is a range of additional activities, including wine tasting and guided tours, whilst the restaurant serves truly delicious fare. At the end of the day we will be leaving Rueda area to discover León. Accommodation in León.

DAY 3 · León - Astorga.

Those interested in medieval history will recognize he name of León, the ancient Spanish kingdom that today forms a province in the autonomous region of Castilla v León. León is the ideal setting for weekend spent discovering its tapas, wines, and the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago. The tour begins with a visit to the magnificent Cathedral, and the chance to admire Castilla y León's own Sistine Chapel in the Basilica of San Isidoro. This will be followed by a tapas route around the Barrio Húmedo (húmedo means 'wet', an adjective that doesn't refer to the rain, but rather to the local custom of washing down evening chats and strolls with wines from the province). A word of warning: this is not a city for vegetarians. León's tapas and its pork products are virtually synonymous. In the afternoon we will make our way to Astorga to visit the magnificent Gaudí Palace. Accommodation in Astorga.

DAY 4 · Stage of the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago: Astorga - Rabanal del Camino (19 Km - Difficulty 1/3).

The first village we come to after leaving Astorga is Murias de Rechivaldo. The Pilgrims' Route starts a gradual ascent to the intersection of Santa Catalina de Somoza before moving onto to El Ganso, after about an hour's walk. It's now time for the last steep slope of the day before we reach the end of the stage in Rabanal del Camino after hiking through an oak forest with its huge Pilgrim's Oak, which provides a resting point for travellers. Possibility of personalising the distance walked or completing the full stage.

Dinner and accommodation in Rabanal del Camino.

DAY 5 · Stage of the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago: Rabanal del Camino - Acebo (17 km - difficulty 2/3). This stage is the highest and one of the most picturesque sections of the Pilgrims' Route with a

mysterious landscape. The Pilgrims' Route leads to the Iron Cross at an altitude of 1,500 metres, a point marked by a simple tall cross on a large wooden post. The route continues on to El Acebo, another famous hamlet and a stop not to be missed, marking our entry into El Bierzo region through the picturesque town of Molinaseca.

Possibility of personalising the distance walked or completing the full stage. Transfer by bus to Ponferrada. Dinner and accommodation in Ponferrada.

DAY 6 · Ponferrada.

This is one of the most beautiful stages on the Pilgrims' Route, you will cross El Bierzo region, a sunken plain nestling within a ring of mountains before arriving in Ponferrada, where the Templar Castle is well worth a visit. In the afternoon we will visit Las Médulas, where we will walk through the largest opencast goldmine in the Roman Empire, recognised as World Heritage Site, whose excavation work formed fantastic natural landscapes. Free time for lunch and dinner. Accommodation in Ponferrada

DAY 7 · Stage of the Pilgrims' Route to Santiago: Ponferrada - Cacabelos (15 Km - Difficulty 1/3) **Bierzo Winery**

Today's walk is less strenuous, covering a total distance of just 15.3 kilometres. It takes us mainly through El Bierzo, an area dotted with vineyards and where, time permitting, we will have the chance to taste the excellent local wine. On leaving Ponferrada we will pass through the suburban village of Compostilla, a former mining town, followed by Columbrianos. Fuentes Nuevas and Camponaraya are two other villages that are very close to each other. Cacabelos is a larger town where it might be worth stopping to visit the Archaeology Museum as well as the church of Santa María de la Plaza. Possibility of personalising the distance walked or completing the full stage.

In the afternoon we will visit a Bierzo winery. Winemaking is based mainly in and around the town of Cacabelos, a village in El Bierzo area standing on the French Way. It is also home to the winner of the world's Best Winemaker Award in the 2014 and 2015 editions. The day's programme includes visits to three wineries and the chance to taste delicious canned food prepared by hand.

Dinner and accommodation in Cacabelos.

DAY 8 • Stage Of The Pilgrims' Route To Santiago: Cacabelos - Pereje (15 Km - Difficulty 2/3).

Pieros and Valtuille de Arriba are the two next villages we will encounter on the way before reaching Villafranca del Bierzo. From Villafranca del Bierzo, where you will be rewarded with a visit to the famous Puerta del Perdón (Door of Forgiveness) in the Church of Saint James, the route brings us to the small village of Pereje.

Possibility of personalising the distance walked or completing the full stage. Finally, we will finish today's stage with a visit to O Cebreiro, a charming Celtic village situated on the Galician side of the border where we will hold a farewell dinner to celebrate our last night. Dinner and accommodation in Ambasmestas.

DAY 9 · Tour ends after breakfast.



VÍA DE LA PLATA ROUTE

DAY 1 · Arrival in Salamanca.

Salamanca or Salmantice is a famous university city renowned around the world for its artistic wealth, which includes cathedrals, palaces and churches, etc, representing a myriad artistic styles. This was one of the reasons why it was included on the UNESCO World Heritage list and named European City of Culture in 2002. The main landmarks are the Plaza Mayor, Casa de las Conchas, the two Cathedrals and the University.

DAY 2 · Salamanca - El Cubo de la Tierra del Vino (35 km).

This stage starts at Plaza Mayor, then continues along the N-630 road towards Zamora, passing through Aldeaseca de Armuña and Castellanos de Villiquera. Shortly after it comes to Calzada de Valdunciel, where you can visit the 12th century church that was rebuilt in the 16th Century; inside, you will find a statue of Saint James Pilgrim. The next stop is in El Cubo de la Tierra del Vino, passing close by Topas Prison. Finally, the route brings you to the first village in the province of Zamora.

DAY 3 · El Cubo de la Tierra del Vino - Zamora (31.6 km).

You leave El Cubo de la Tierra del Vino and take the old road, once you reach the top of a hill, you will be able to see Villanueva de Campeán. You enter the village taking a path that leads to San Marcial, before walking up a hill where you will be able to see Zamora in the distance. You will enter Zamora via the borough of San Frontis, which affords spectacular views of the Cathedral. Bordering the River Douro, passing by the ruins of a Roman bridge on your left, you will enter the city by crossing the medieval bridge. This is one of the most important sites for pilgrims following the Silver Route as it was here that the idea of reviving this ancient pilgrims' route was first conceived. Zamora is an authentic jewel of Romanesque architecture, boasting more examples of this style than anywhere else in Europe.

DAY 4 · Zamora - Montamarta (18.5 km).

Today's route starts in the Main Square. After crossing the city, take the ZA-900 road, where you will see the Rey Don Santo Cross and a stele that marks the kilometres remaining before Santiago de Compostela: 377 (2.5 km).

A few kilometres bring you to Roales del Pan and the end of today's stage in Montamarta.

DAY 5 · Montamarta - Granja de Moreruela (22.7 km).

Leaving Montamarta, you will go past the Ricobayo Reservoir, and the Church of La Virgen del Castillo. From here, continue along the N-630

road until you see the ruins of Castrotorafe Castle. Next, continue in the direction of Fontanillas de Castro, where you enter the small town, and a few kilometres further on you will come to Riego del Camino, another small town that will bring you to the end of the stage in Granja de Moreruela.

DAY 6 · Granja de Moreruela - Tábara (25.3 km).

After taking the time to admire the magnificent monastery, you will leave Granja de Moreruela and head towards Foramontanos de Tábara, a small town whose principal attraction are the intriguing wineries.

On leaving this small town, you will walk through magnificent oak groves that bring you to Tábara, where the first thing you will see is the church

Day 7 · Tábara - Santa Marta de Tera (23 km).

On leaving Tábara you will walk through the villages of Bercianos de Valverde and Santa Crova de Tera. This is an easy and attractive section of the route, lined with vineyards, chestnut and poplar trees.

The inhabitants of these two towns are renowned for their hospitality and will be only too happy to show you round and offer all kinds of helpful advice and tips. Don't miss the opportunity to stop and chat with the people you meet on the way. It will never be a waste of time.

You will eventually come to Santa Marta de Tera.

DAY 8 · Santa Marta de Tera - Rionegro del Puente (27. 5 km).

After leaving Santa Marta de Tera, you will walk along a peaceful track, bringing you to Vega del Tera. Shortly after you will come to Calzadilla de Tera, where you will have free time. The next town is Olleros de Tera, which stands out for its adobe and straw houses. This abandoned village is the ideal spot to stop and rest.

DAY 9 · Rionegro del Puente - Entrepeñas (22 km).

You leave Rionegro del Puente, passing through small towns such as Monbuey, Valdemirilla, Cernadilla and San Salvador de Palazuelos, ending at Entrepeñas.

DAY 10 · Entrepeñas - Puebla de Sanabria (18.5 km).

Leaving Entrepeñas, this final stage will take you through beautiful small towns like Asturianos, Remesal, Triufe and before ending the route at one of the most striking towns in Spain, Puebla de Sanabria.







THE VALLEY OF GREDOS ON HORSE

DAY 1 · Madrid - Navarredonda de Gredos.

Transfer from Madrid to Navarredonda de Gredos, a small village in the heart of Castile with a splendid view of the Sierra de Gredos. This is a region steeped in history, where the Moors and Christians fought, where Romans built roads that have lasted for centuries. Riders will enjoy a welcome dinner and night at the Gredos National Parador.

DAY 2 • The Pinewoods and the summer pastures. The source of the Tormes River.

Circle ride from Navarredonda with a picnic lunch in the countryside. Ride through pine woods, open fields and trails, towards the mountains with great views of the Sierra de Gredos. Picnic lunch in the countryside. In the afternoon ride back to the stables in Navarredonda, returning for dinner and overnight as the previous night. This day is a short ride so riders and horses get used to each other. If any change of horse is necessary it can be done, before leaving the next day and for the rest of the ride. A nice small Spa has been open in the next village (5 min away). It is possible to arrange a session – a special rider's massage – in the evening before dinner.

DAY 3 · Along the Tormes River Navarredonda de Gredos – Navalperal de Tormes

Morning through woods and beautiful meadows in the Tormes river valley. We will follow the course of the Tormes River. Lunch at the Pozo de las Paredes, a magic spot at the gorge of Barbellido, which joins the Tormes River. This spot is ideal for a swim in summer. In the afternoon, riders will follow the cattle path, with great views, to Navalperal de Tormes. This night riders will stay at a new rural hotel near the Tormes River.

DAY 4 · The Cattle path to El Barco de Ávila Navalperal de Tormes – El Barco de Ávila. half day Ride.

This day it will be a long half day ride. It is a progressive ride to get to El Barco. A ride along the Tormes River valley, along cattle paths, passing the village of Aliseda de Tormes. Riders will appreciate the change in the vegetation as they will approach the small town of El Barco de Ávila. The hotel in Barco de Ávila is a country hotel, a luxurious hotel built as a restoration of a ancient country estate. The hotel has a spa and an indoor heated pool, a good chance for a rest to be fresh for the rest of the ride. Afternoon free to visit El Barco de Ávila or just relax in the hotel. El Barco

de Ávila is a 15th century walled village with a medieval bridge stretching over the Tormes

DAY 5 • Into the province of Salamanca El Barco de Ávila – Hoyorredondo.

Today's ride proceeds through holm oaks woods and pastures, following the cattle track between Barco and Hoyorredondo, arriving in Puente del Congosto, with a XVth century bridge and castle for lunch. Picnic near the river – a beautiful spot for a swim in the summer. In the afternoon there will be a fun short ride to Hoyorredondo. Night at a beautiful and comfortable rural hotel.

DAY 6 • The Corneja River Valley and over the mountains to the Alberche River Valley Hoyorredondo – San Martín de la Vega.

A day with great contrasts in the landscape. The ride starts in the valley of the Corneja River, open flat valleys until we reach the aperitif stop. We follow the river Corneja to its source, and stop for lunch near one of the water mills along the river. In the afternoon follow a Roman road up to the Puerto de Chia (5,686 feet) for a panoramic view of the Corneja Valley on one side, and the Alberche River on the other. Descend to San Martin de la Vega where the horses will spend the night. Short transfer to a charming rural hotel in Barajas de Gredos.

DAY 7 • Back to views of The Sierra de Gredos San Martín de la Vega – Navarredonda de Gredos.

Last day back to the Sierra de Gredos, with some great views of the peaks of the Sierra. Descent towards the Tormes valley where we started. Picnic lunch with panoramic views of the Sierra de Gredos. Short afternoon, with some good canters, back to the stables. Night and farewell dinner at the Parador.

DAY 8 · Navarredonda – Madrid.

After breakfast transfer to Madrid, arriving there about 12 noon. All riders will be transferred at the same time, so if any rider needs to arrive in Madrid prior to noon, all riders will depart earlier - or we will arrange an alternative transfer (at an extra cost).

The pace of the ride varies with the terrain. Overall it is a moderate pace, with some slow parts due to the mountainous terrain. There are open areas through the valleys where it is possible to canter with excellent tracks for exciting rides. The average riding time is five to six hours per day.
