# <u>CARLOS V ROUTE</u>

Carlos V, the Medieval emperor, was a keen globetrotter and chose Castilla y León for his final trip. Today, this historical and geographical route passes through 24 cities in the region.

The route passes through the regions of Cantabria, Castilla y León and Extremadura, reliving the time when Carlos I de España y V de Alemania disembarked in Laredo in Cantabria on September 26, 1556, to spend the rest of his days in the Monasterio de Yuste in Caceres where he died on the 21st September 1558.

The emperor's pilgrimage through Castilla y León lasted a month and 3 days, starting on the 8th October and finishing on the 10th November 1556. The route offers tourists the chance to visit villages and areas of extraordinary natural beauty, the deep-rooted culture of the people, reflected by their traditions, legends, fiestas and lifestyle.

As they pass through Castilla y León, tourists will be left with the mark of its monuments, gastronomy and the sights offered by a modern region that keeps its traditions and the legacy of its past alive. It goes through a large number of localities, such as Medina de Pomar in Burgos, Venta de Baños in Palencia, Cabezon de Pisuerga or Medina del Campo in Valladolid, Peñaranda de Bracamonte in the province of Salamanca and El Barco de Avila, in the province of Avila too.

## PALACE OF POLENTINOS MUSEUM OF THE LOGISTICS CORPS AND GENERAL MILITARY ARCHIVES

This beautiful 16th century palace houses the General Military Archives and the Museum of the Logistics Corps (Cuerpo de Intendencia). The Logistics Corps Museum includes six areas that display the evolution of the Logistics Corps from its founding, tied to administrative areas of the Spanish Army, to the present day. At the museum a "cadet" welcomes you at the door of what for so many years was his home. There are many surprises waiting inside: the recreation of a famous Renaissance tapestry from the Conquest of Tunis, scale models of different types of wagons, a room of historical flags, the equestrian statue of the first standard bestowed upon the troops of the Logistics Corps, figures from the corps explaining the Spanish Road. Visitors may notice that the upper body of some of them have been fashioned from Kinder egg capsules covered in paper pulp. Tel. 920352521. #### **BEECH FORESTS**

One of the most mysterious forests, especially beautiful in autumn with an impressive display of thousands of colours visitors can appreciate, are beech forests. In Burgos province they are found in mountainous, rainy areas. Many are also found in protected natural spaces and offer signposted walking trails with different levels of difficulty. One of the most popular is the beech forest in Santa Cruz del Valle Urbión, where the Enrique del Rivero Path leads to a spectacular tree, known as the "most famous beech tree in Burgos". There are other wonderful beech forests in Monte Santiago Natural Monument, the Hayedos del Humión in Montes Obarenes or the Mena Valley, and the beech forests in Leciñana and Haedo Visiting them is a great day out.

#### ON TOUR IN CABRERA LEONESA


Cabrera Leonesa is located in the southeast of the province and holds outstanding natural beauty and cultural heritage. Traditional architecture is distinguished by the use of slate sheets, with prominent balconies and external stairways made from large stones. You can find some examples in the town of Villar del Monte, where you can also pay a visit to the Castile and Leon Museum of Lace or explore local traditions in the Cultural Centre. Towns such as Iruela and Forna also offer interesting architectural cases. There is the outstanding Cabrera Museum in Encinedo and the Chocolate Museum in Castrocontrigo. The Romans built a number of canals in Cabrera to supply water to the gold mines, the traces of which can still be seen on the hillsides. You can travel sections of them in Peña Aguda or Saceda. One of the most accessible stretches is near the Virgen del Valle shrine between Llamas de Cabrera and Odollo. Near the village of Corporales is the Corona archaeological site which houses two pre-Roman forts. You can round off your visit by sampling some of the traditional dishes from the region, made with local produce, such as the caldo cabreriés broth of cabbage, beans, and potatoes seasoned with chorizo, ham, and bacon.

## 2021 JACOBEO HOLY YEAR. "LUX" ON THE WAY OF ST. JAMES GRAND EXHIBITION OF RELIGIOUS ART BY LAS EDADES DEL HOMBRE FOUNDATION

The "LUX" grand exhibition is still open on the Way of St. James for the 2021 Jacobeo Holy Year. The Edades del Hombre Foundation has organised the twenty-fifth edition of this wonderful display, which includes breathtaking pieces of artistic heritage. The exhibition is spread over three provinces and five venues in the towns of Burgos, Carrión de los Condes, and Sahagún. In Carrión de los Condes (Palencia) the exposition begins in the church of Santa María del Camino o de las Victorias and continues into the church of Santiago Apóstol, which are both Romanesque in style. Both churches have stunning porticos portraying history and legend in their carving. In this picturesque town on the Way of St. James you can also visit the Santa Clara monastery, which this year is keeping its World Nativity Scenes exhibition of almost 2,000 exhibits open all year. The magnificent San Zoilo monastery and its library devoted to the Way of St. James and pilgrimages is also worth a visit. Plantío park offers the opportunity for a lovely stroll along the banks of the River Carrión. And, of course, no visit would be complete without trying the rich local cuisine.

#### THE MUDEIAR ROUTE

North-eastern Salamanca, specifically the districts of Alba and Peñaranda, is well known for its beautiful Mudejar churches. The Mudejar style was developed in the province of Salamanca in the 12 and 13th centuries from the adaptation of Mudejar techniques to the Romanesque style, replacing stone walls and vaults with brick walls and wooden coffering. This route includes 16 temples that represent the syncretism of Christian art and Islamic aesthetics. In Alba de Tormes, the well-preserved churches of Santiago and San Juan house a triple apse and majestic image of the twelve apostles. Although simple in construction, the artistic qualities of the naves, apses, and arches is astonishing, as can be seen in the churches of Coca, Galleguillos, Peñarandilla, Turra, Aldeaseca de la Frontera, Gajates, Nava de Sotrobal, Paradinas de San Juan, Rágama, Pedrosillo, and Villar de Gallimazo. One of the hidden treasures in this route is the splendid coffering on display inside the churches of Macotera, Cantaracillo, Rágama, and Villoria, which reached their golden age a little later in the 16th century.

#### VILLACASTÍN

Considered "The Cathedral of the Mountains", the church of San Sebastian is one of the marvels built in the age of economic and social splendour of Castile. Linked to Rodrigo Gil de Hontañón, who built the naves and domes, and Fray Antón de Villacastín, a trusted servant of Felipe II, who worked on the exterior. This makes it Gothic in style inside and Herrerian in the exterior. It has three naves with graceful columns and ribbed vaults and boasts Renaissance reredos, which are more than worth taking your time to admire. The town is also home to various shrines and a one-of-a-kind monument: the stork monument, which is one of very few of its type in Spain to honour this endearing animal. Lastly, if you are keen for a country stroll, Villacastín has several options. Two of the biggest drover's roads in Spain and Portugal pass through here: the Cañada Real Soriana Occidental and the Cañada Real Leonesa Oriental. There is also the option of the Fresneda area with its oak trees and peonies.

## MONCAYO INTERPRETATION CENTRE IN CUEVA DE ÁGREDA + MONCAYO BEECH FOREST + THE SOURCE OF THE RIVER QUEILES.

The Moncayo Interpretation Centre, in Cueva de Ágreda, aims to provide information on the Moncayo Range in Soriano and on the bats living in the cave which the town is named after. One of the floors explains the geological formation of the Moncayo range, the flora and fauna, and the history of the people who have lived there. The Moncayo Beech Forest is one of the most southernly Beech forests in Europe. The Moncayo Beech Forest Route is marked as PR-SO 79 and covers a total of 9.8km, starting in Aldehuela de Ágreda. The first section to the Agramonte trail is an out-and-back walk, whilst the rest of the route is circular. An important river source in Soria province is the source of the river Queiles, which lies to the southeast of the village of Vozmediano at an altitude of one thousand metres. It flows continuously from a cave in a spectacular, explosive, deafening, bubbling current. A lovely walk from the centre of the hamlet offering views of the castle brings us to this wonderful landscape.

#### **VALLADOLID HEALTH SPAS**

A spa is a site which has medicinal mineral water. The difference in the water is the result of geological origin. Water heated by hot rocks flows at temperatures of up to 50°C whilst groundwater is more filtered and can appear in any location at lower temperatures. Spas are recommended for people experiencing problems related to their skin, circulation, rheumatism, and kidneys, as well as being a lovely place to spend a few days relaxing and resting. Bathing in thermal springs increases body temperature, which kills germs and viruses, increases hydrostatic pressure, which increases blood flow and oxygen supply. This increase in temperature helps dissolve and eliminate toxins in the body.

In autumn, the forests are full of mushrooms and mushroom lovers flock to the countryside in search of their favourite varieties. Zamora is one of the top 5 destinations for mushroom tourists. The districts of Sanabria, La Carballeda, and Aliste are three of the most typical regions of Zamora province where you can enjoy picking mushrooms, as well as trying out the finest dishes at the mushroom events hosted by restaurants in the province and visiting the Fungi Interpretation Centre in Rabanales. This centre and the Mycology School in Ungilde run countryside trips where you can pick saffron milk caps, boletus, russula, and many other varieties. With over 500 recorded species of mushrooms, Zamora province has one of the highest concentrations of mushroom production in Spain. Visitors can get a two-day recreational pass for €10 which allows them to explore the mushroom-growing areas in the project and collect up to 3kg of mushrooms per day.
