

Museum of the Monastery of Santa Isabel



It is in the monastery of Santa Isabel, from the XVI century, and retains sculptures of Gregorio Fernandez and Juan de Juni. It stand out the paintings attributed to Diego Valentin Diaz, the chapel of the jurist Francisco de Espinosa and the space devoted to the monastery kitchen utensils.

Buildings

Monastery of Santa Isabel: 15th century convent. Church of only one nave with arched vault. The cloister dates back to the 16th century and contains cells. The main altar is the same design as the Colegiata de Villargarcía de Campos and is in two parts and an end room. It houses a Sculpture Museum with works by Gregorio Fernández and Juan de Juni.
