

Canyons and viewpoints



The focal point of this route is the River Duero, which has shaped the rocky crags that characterise the Arribes area, known as the 'fresh water cliffs' and where visitors will find various viewpoints from which to admire this breathtakingly beautiful landscape, inhabited by numerous species of wildlife, including vultures and eagles.

Stunning scenery that can be admired from anywhere in the Arribes del Duero region: la Faya in Villarino de los Aires; the Chapel of La Virgen del Castillo en Pereña; the viewpoints at Felipe Peak or the Friar's Balcony in Aldeadávila de la Ribera; La Code viewpoint in Mieza; Vilvestre Castle or Las Janas viewpoint in Saucelle.
