

Museo Vestigia - Leyenda del Camino



It is a multimedia montage in three dimensions, covering the stories, miracles and legends of the Camino de Santiago. Entering this museum means delving into the history and origins of Frómista, through images, light, sound, talking statues, panoramic screens, being able to enjoy a 35-minute journey through history in a unique setting such as the Church of Santa María del Castillo, declared BIC since 1944.

Buildings

Church of Santa Maria del Castillo: Asset of Cultural Interest since 1944, in a late Gothic style (15th - 18th centuries). Located in the highest part of the town, it was the place where the old castle of the town was settled, which today gives its name to the temple. Today the multimedia montage Vestigia, Leyenda del Camino is located there, which, through images and sound, recovers the stories and legends of Frómista and those of the Camino de Santiago.
